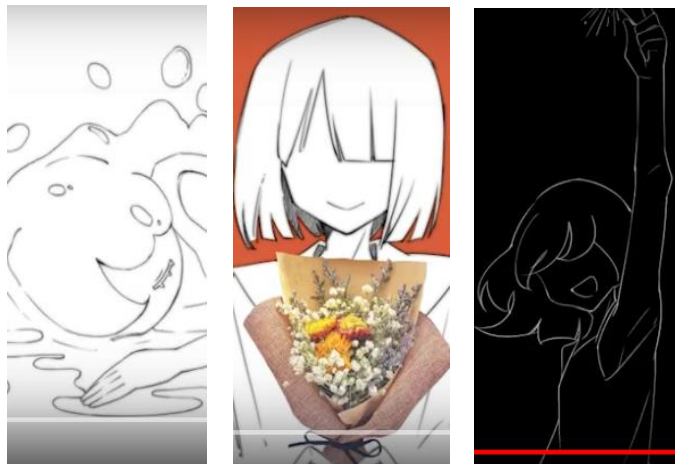


SOUND ROTATION
